

Wild coffee, or Psychotria nervosa, is a native plant that is especially well-suited to Pine Run and can be found throughout the community. It likes full to partial shade, and is moderately drought tolerant. While its berries resemble coffee beans, they contain no caffeine. Its white flowers attract both bees and butterflies. Its red berries attract birds. The flowers and berries, along with the shiny, deep green leaves and impressed veins make it an extremely attractive plant. There are no major pests or diseases that threaten this plant. If you are looking for a hedge plant near your unit, there is no need to go out and

purchase these plants, there are many established areas of wild coffee where small plants could be removed for transplanting.
