Pine Run Motor Scooter policy

Residents may park up to two motor scooters in their assigned carport or parking space upon approval from the Board. A motor scooter is defined as a light, two-wheeled, open motor vehicle on which the driver sits over an enclosed engine with legs together and feet resting on a floor board. One, or two motor scooters are considered a vehicle under this policy. Therefore, according to Pine Run parking policy, a resident may also have one other vehicle which can be parked in any unassigned parking space. At no time may the scooter or scooters and another vehicle be parked in the same carport or assigned parking space. All other rules also apply. Motor scooters must be operated quietly within Pine Run property, and drivers must respect the Pine Run Speed limit.
